



## APPLICATION OF YOUR WALL DECALS - PLEASE READ THESE TIPS BEFORE APPLYING YOUR DECALS.

Be prepared, some of the larger, more intricate designs can take a while and preferably a 2 person job.

Its a very simple process but with a few handy tips, you'll get it right first time.

Peel off the design from the backing paper and position it wherever you think it will be going on the wall, just roughly will do at first so you can play around with it when you think its in a good position. Its very low tack at this stage so you can easily reposition it if you need to.

Large designs are printed in sections to make it easier to get it in place on the wall. You will need a helping hand with the larger designs.

Its a good idea to start peeling off the intricate areas of designs first before trying to remove a piece in one go to avoid any ripping.

Try not to let the adhesive attach itself to the backing reverse side of the backing paper.

When you have your design in place you may need to heat all of the decals which is best with a hair dryer all over the design paying particular attention to the edges, you can then get a bank card and push the decal against the wall until it adheres (preferably put the card inside a sock or pillow case or any thin material to help protect the artwork).

Some walls may take a little more effort to get this material sticking to the wall. Its a one size fits all kind of material so for some walls it may stick straight away.

This heating process activates the adhesive which makes it alot stickier so it should stay firm thereafter, if it does ever peel again then simply reheat it. This is rarely needed but has happened on rare occasions on very uneven/textured surfaces or on shiny/glossy surfaces.

## REMOVING THE DECALS


The same process is also recommended for removing the decals, especially if they've been inlace a while. Just heat them up then carefully remove them, paying attention to intricate areas first. Its a good idea to keep the backing paper and tube just incase you do want to reuse these at a later date.

# WALL DECAL / STICKER APPLICATION DETAILS



STEP 1.

Clean the surface thoroughly



STEP 2.

Tape your design to your surface to help plan where you think it may go. (before peeling off the backing paper)

You may want to cut around each separate decal if you have one of the large wall designs thoroughly, paying particular attention to the edges



STEP 3.

Peel back the decal from the backing paper. Start with any intricate areas before the main, larger sections to prevent tearing.



STEP 4.

On a high heat, warm up the decal thoroughly, paying particular attention to the edges



STEP 5.

Press down firmly whilst the decal is still heated, paying particular attention to the edges. If the decal peels at all just heat and repeat this part of the process.
